Objectives

- Create a list of links
- Use css to float text beside images
- Use css to push text under an image

Initial Steps

1. Make a *folder* named **hw4** *firstname lastname* – for example:

hw4JimElam

2. With-in your **hw4** folder, make a subfolder called **images**.
3. For this assignment you will need two 2 medium-sized images (no bigger than 200 x 200) of your choice. Place the images you will use into the **images** folder.
4. Create your Web page (.html) file in notepad++ (you may wish to start with **template.html**).
5. Name your .html file **lastname firstinitial hw4.html**, with no spaces. For example:

elamjhw4.html

Make a Web Page that contains the following:

1. Links to at least 3 external sites that you think are good sites (well-constructed, eye-catching, informational yet simple, easy to navigate, etc.)
 - Use an unordered list to display the links – nest each link tag `<a>` inside a list item tag ``
 - Open each page you link to in a new window. If necessary, refer to www.w3schools.com click on **HTML 4.01** or **XHTML 1.0**, then click on `<a>`.

2. **Option 1:** include 2 medium-sized images (no bigger than 200 x 200) of your choice. Place one image to the left and the other to the right. Wrap a paragraph beside each image – you can copy paragraphs from www.lipsum.com if you wish. In addition to wrapping a paragraph beside each image, include a paragraph that starts **after** (below) each image.

OR

Option 2 (Extra Credit): Have the two images appear on the same line: one on the left side of the page; the other on the right. Wrap a paragraph of text **between** the two images. Include a second paragraph that starts after (below) the images.

3. Create styles as needed to make the page attractive.
