

Read this entire handout before you start

Overview

For this assignment you will use Google or another search engine to locate answers to the following 5 questions:

1. In order from largest to smallest, what are the 5 largest cities, by population, in the United States?
2. Google **email etiquette** List at least 5 to 7 rules for writing and sending effective, professional e-mails. List the rules in any order.
3. What is the difference between how a **typical virus** infects a computer and how a **worm** infects a computer?
4. What does File Transfer Protocol (FTP) software do?
5. What is shareware?

You will create a web page (.html file) that will display the following information **for each question**:

- o The question itself (you can paraphrase)
- o The answer or information you located
- o A link to the Web page where you located the answer/information.

For each answer, use the appropriate html tag. For example, if the answer is a list use the appropriate list tag: ordered list - - or unordered list – ul.

You may wish to draw a sketch of the page before create it.

Getting Started

1. Under your CIS133 folder, **create a new folder** for this assignment. Name it **lastnamewebhw2**, with no spaces, for example:

`e1amwebhw2`

Open the folder and create a subfolder call images.

You will need to use a background image for this assignment. You can use one of your own or one from S:\Faculty\Elam\Cis_133\images

Create your web page (.html) file in notepad++ (or some other text editor). You should start by opening **template.html**, then immediately go to File, Save as. Save the file in the folder you created and name it **lastnameweb2.html**, with no spaces, for example:

`e1amweb2.html`

Requirements

Include the following tags in your Web Page correctly. For example use an ordered list - - when it is appropriate to do so (you may use other tags as well):

In the head section create a style for the body tag that adds a ***background image***.

Create a CSS style to format ***each*** of the following tags. Use at least 2 format rules for each tag. For example center h1 and change the font.

Make your page easy to scan and read, and pleasing to look at.

1. A printout of the code.
