

## Description

- For this assignment, you will take the presidents page - **index.html** - from assign #1 and create a 5 page site from it.
- The site will consist of the following pages:
  - index.html**
  - washington.html**
  - jefferson.html**
  - linclon.html**
  - kennedy.html**

## Initial Steps

- 1) Start Dreamweaver
- 2) If necessary, open the *Presidents* Site Definition you created in Assign #1 (Top of the Files Panel)
- 3) Double-click on **index.html** to open it.
- 4) Set the Title of **index.html** to: **Assign #2 – Presidential Anecdotes.**

## Move the styles to an external style sheet

- 1) In the CSS panel use <ctrl> **click** or <shift> **click** to highlight all the styles for **index.html**
- 2) Make sure you are in the highlighted area and right-click.
- 3) Select **move CSS rules ...** from the pop-up menu.
- 4) A dialog box will appear; click on **a new style sheet ...** then click **OK.**
- 5) Name the style sheet **presidents.css**

## Creating the sub pages

- 1) In the Files Panel select **index.html**
- 2) Hold down the Control key and press “D” four times to make 4 duplicate files
- 3) Renames the four copies as follows:  
**washington.html**  
**linclon.html**  
**jefferson.html**  
**kennedy.html**
- 4) Open **washington.html** and do the following:
  - a. Change the main heading to: **Presidential Anecdotes – Washington**
  - b. Delete the information about the other presidents from the page
- 5) Repeat step 4 with **lincoln.html**, **jefferson.html** and **kennedy.html**

## Create a list of links

- 1) Open index.html and position at the end of the Main Heading (Presidential Anecdotes). press Enter to insert a line under the heading.
- 2) Add an unordered list, type “Home” as the text of the first list item. Type the 4 president’s names for the remaining list items.
- 3) Make each list item link to the following pages:

<b>Home</b>	<b>index.html</b>
<b>Washington</b>	<b>washington.html</b>
<b>Jefferson</b>	<b>jefferson.html</b>
<b>Lincoln</b>	<b>lincoln.html</b>
<b>Kennedy</b>	<b>kennedy.html</b>

## Create a Custom Horizontal Nav Bar

- 1) Create styles to turn the list into a horizontal navigation bar – refer to the “Creating a Horizontal Nav Bar” Handout.
- 2) Go to the code window and highlight the entire unordered list – from <ul> to </ul>
- 3) Go to **washington.html**, open the code window, position after </h1> and press Enter.
- 4) Paste the unordered list.
- 5) Repeat steps 3 and 4 with the other pages. Save all the files
- 6) Press F12 and test all the links to make sure they work.

## Submit

1. A code printout for **index.html** and **presidents.css**
2. Publish the page to the server. Go to your site on the Internet and test the link. For example:

*www.jimlam.com/yourUserName/presidents*

*Check all the subpages, make sure all the links work.*
